

Lincoln Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers Public Relations Officer

The Lincoln Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers wish to recruit a Public Relations Officer to organise and coordinate public relations and communications. The Guild is currently in a period of review and change with the objective of increasing the number of ringers in Lincolnshire and increasing the number of towers where the bells are rung regularly for church and community. This new office is seen as being a key part of achieving these objectives.

The appointment is subject to ratification by the Guild Committee and by members at a Guild AGM.

Terms of Reference

- to foster goodwill and mutual understanding between ringers and the general public;
- to foster public awareness of ringing;
- to establish and maintain goodwill and mutual understanding between the Guild and significant non-ringing bodies (including the media, church and local government);
- to establish and maintain goodwill and mutual understanding between the Guild Officers, Branches and individual ringers;
- to establish and maintain a comprehensive and effective communications system between committees, officers, and guild members.

General Duties

This is a new position and the person appointed will be required to lead the setting up of the office and creating a range of policies and activities to meet the Terms of Reference. The Public Relations Officer will be a key member of the Guild Committee who will oversee the work of the new office.
