The booking process and guidance materials may be reviewed and amended as necessary.

The Wombel or Sixbel towers may be borrowed by towers or branches. There is no charge for borrowing the equipment, but those borrowing the equipment will be responsible for transporting it to and from their venue. They will also need to ensure that there is **at least four able-bodied helpers available** to assemble and disassemble the tower, including someone who has been **appropriately trained**.

Guild Insurance covers all personnel involved in the assembly and use of the equipment. However, it does not cover damage to the equipment, so care must be taken, and the lap top locked away when not supervised.

When agreement is reached on borrowing the equipment it will be listed in the calendar below.
