It has been suggested that we should hold a basic bell maintenance session for those who would like to know a little more about the upkeep of their bells.

The proposed tower is **Ruskington** as there is reasonable access to the bells on **Saturday 9th April** from 5.00pm until 6.00pm followed by a picnic tea then ringing 7.00pm until 8.30pm.

Items covered in the session would be:-

1. Health & Safety.
2. Rope inspections, attaching ropes to wheels possibly splicing.
3. Lubrication – plain bearings, ball bearings, clappers, gudgeons and wheels.
4. Frame Maintenance, tightening, checking all nuts & bolts, rope pulleys, stays, sliders, headstocks and painting.
5. Cleanliness.
